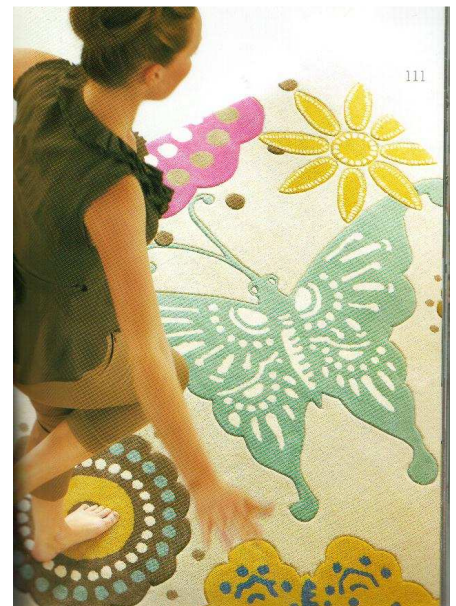
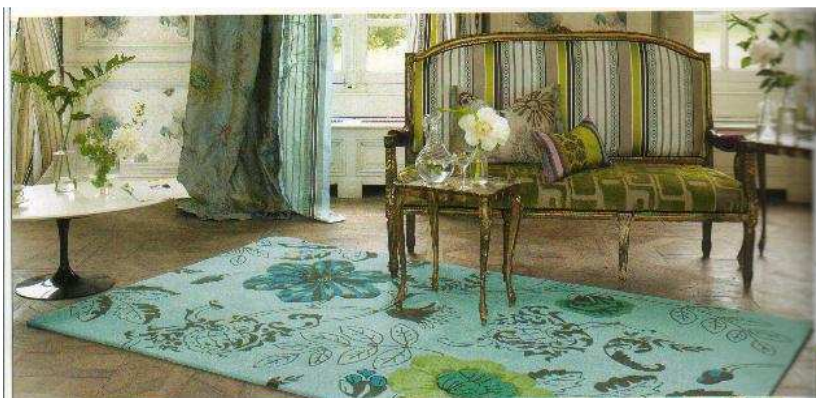

WHAT MAKES FURNITURE TIMELESS?

Timeless is a concept that is central to our design ethos. It's been an interesting exercise to quiz various people in the design industry as to what they believe makes furniture timeless.

Referencing the Collins definition of timeless (unaffected or unchanged by time; ageless), opinions canvassed were relatively consistent. The key themes were: it has an intrinsic enduring quality; it just doesn't date; it has a classic value to it.

Classic is a term that I believe is too often misconstrued as traditional and yet is essentially about timelessness. The dictionary definition of classic is "continuously in fashion because of its style". This is why I see the two terms as interchangeable.

When designing, we always have timelessness/classic qualities in mind. The litmus test we run asks the questions: Could this design be pigeon-holed as from a specific era? Could this design sit comfortably in a modern and a traditional setting? Would it be as relevant in 20 years time as it was 20 years ago?
